on 28 November 2022, EFSA received a Mandate from the European Commission (EC) to assess whether the conclusions for the adopted Scientific Opinions on stacks containing MIR 162 remain valid (EFSA-Q-2022-00853).

EFSA and its GMO Panel, have identified questions that need further clarifications (see attached Annex). Pending the delivery of the requested information, EFSA and its GMO Panel cannot proceed with the assessment of the Additional information on maize MIR162.

To optimise EFSA workflow, please confirm within 30 calendar days as from the date of receipt of this Letter, by e-mail, your availability to submit the supplementary information to EFSA by the timeline specified in the attached Annex. In the Annex, you will find the details of this request as well as the corresponding timeline.

The requested information shall be accompanied by a signed copy of the cover letter. A version of the requested information that can be used for public access purposes by EFSA and/or by EC should be provided too.
